STUDENT CODE OF CONDUCT.

1. Not allowed

These things are not allowed on the premises: alcohol, tobacco, controlled substances, firearms, knives or weapons of any kind. If a student breaks this rule, they will be asked to leave immediately.

2. Zero Tolerance!

Stage Right seeks to offer an environment free from bullying and harassment in a community that strives to treat every student with sensitivity and respect. This means that Stage Right will not tolerate harassment or bullying of students because of race, sex, ideology, sexual orientation, socio-economic level, age, national origin, religion or other issues. Verbal, written or physical abuse, and more subtle, but equally damaging forms of harassment, such as Internet postings, graffiti, epithets and stereotypical remarks will not be tolerated.

3. Support one another

In this field sometimes you will get the part and sometimes you won't. Regardless of that every student pledges to be supportive of one another.

4. Do your homework!

Students are expected to memorize scene work or monologues for acting class as well as any other homework that is given to you by your instructors.

5. The work is what's important

What separates Stage Right students from other students is their work ethic. Hard work in classes and rehearsals and a willingness to try your best is required of everyone.

6. What you wear is important

PROPER ATTIRE IS REQUIRED AT ALL TIMES! You are coming here to work which means wearing clothes that are appropriate. We ask you wear nothing too tight or revealing, no flip flops or bare feet in dance class (Unless the instructor asks you go barefoot) and rehearsal attire that allows you to move.

7. If you don't know ask

If a student has a concern, question, comment or complaint they are to come directly to a staff member, as opposed to saying it to other students. There is no place for unprofessional behavior in a professional atmosphere.
